SEX OFFENDER INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL

Title I of the Adam Walsh Child Protection and Safety Act of 2006, the Sex Offender Registration and Notification Act (SORNA), requires that registered sex offenders inform registry officials (Maricopa County SO office) **IN PERSON OF ANY INTENDED TRAVEL OUTSIDE OF THE UNITED STATES A MINIMUM 21 DAYS BEFORE THE START OF THAT TRAVEL.**

ALL THE INFORMATION BELOW IS REQUIRED TO BE TYPED OR IN LEGIBLE HANDWRITING:

Identifying Information

- Full name (last, first, middle)
- Date of birth
- Citizenship
- Passport number and country (provide actual passport)

Travel Information

- Purpose(s) of travel (business, vacation, military, relocation, deportation, other [specify])
- Means of travel (air, bus, car, ship, train, other [specify])
- U.S. departure date and location
- U.S. return date and location

Other

- Itinerary details, including the name of the airport/train station/port, the flight/train/ship number, the time of departure, the time of arrival, and information about any intermediate stops, including any cities/towns within countries and points of arrival/departure from each country
- Contact information within the destination country
- Foreign travel visa information

Destination Country Laws

Notification to U.S. authorities does not guarantee entry into another country. Many nations have strict border entry policies that restrict or outright ban convicted sex offenders from entering. It is highly recommended to check with the embassy or consulate of your destination country well in advance of your 21-day notification window to verify their policies.
